



Kenworth T680-T880-W990 December 2018+ PeopleNet Connected Gateway™ Install



- This document covers Kenworth T680-880-990 vehicles built in or after <u>December of 2018</u>.
- Vehicles built November 2018 or before will require the 9-Pin PCG cable. Refer to the relevant document at https://mobility.trimble.com/installations/ for details.



Install Steps



- 1) Connect and mount the display.
- 2) Connect and mount the PCG.
- 3) Connect the display blue barrel and 2-pin power to the PCG Main Cable. Non-Trimble displays will not require the blue barrel.
- 4) Connect the PCG RP1226 Main Cable to the vehicle's RP1226 connector.

NOTE: The cable may require a re-pin as shown below.



RP1226 Cable Re-pin

Peterbilt and Kenworth use pin 1 for power, rather than the more standard pin 14. Follow these steps to re-pin the Trimble RP1226 connector.




<u>1</u> Use needle-nose pliers to remove the red pin cover.





<u>2</u> Use a small pick or screwdriver to release the lock on the power pin (brown wire), then gently pull the pin out from the back.






Display Option 1






Display Option 2





Diagnostic Connection – On-Dash









Connect the PCG Main Cable to the RP1226 connector above the fuse panel, making sure the brown lead matches
